



**Darfur - The Worst
Humanitarian Crisis
in the World Today**



Since conflict erupted across Sudan in 2023, millions have lost their homes, food is scarce, families are desperate. Famine has been announced.

Children - and animals – are dying from starvation and curable diseases. Schools across the country have been closed for over a year. Hospitals are barely functioning. In remote villages there is no health care. The health of children is closely linked to the health of the animals, yet there is no veterinary care.

Worst of all - food is desperately scarce.

Families living in remote villages in Darfur are subsistence farmers, living off whatever they can grow from the land. Crops have not been planted due to the violence, and after a failed crop last year, families were already malnourished before the start of the conflict in April 2023.



Many children are surviving on one scant meal a day; many adults have just one meal every two to three days. Worryingly this is often just a carbohydrate called assida, resulting in serious malnourishment. Thousands of families have been forced to flee their homes because they simply cannot survive with nothing to eat. Inflation has rocketed – over 300% and rising.

Children need us right now.

Together, we must help feed starving children in Darfur! - But how?



Children across Darfur are in desperate need of food containing essential protein, minerals and vitamins.

We are now providing **Kids Kitchen Kits**, including lentils, ground nuts, vegetable oil and fresh vegetables - nutritious ingredients which are otherwise unaffordable for families.

These Kits will supply the essential proteins and minerals for malnourished children who face stunted growth, bone, teeth, hair and even brain damage through lack of vital nutrients.

£25 will provide a Kids Kitchen Kit to a family with children aged 5 and under.

Today we have 110 Kids for Kids' Villages in Darfur, Sudan - and they are growing as families seek a better chance of survival.

In these villages, our sustainable projects are proving more valuable than we could ever have imagined.

Our **Goats** are providing protein-rich milk for malnourished children. Our **Handpumps** are being used day and night for clean, safe drinking water. Our **Trees** are stabilising the desert. Many provide an additional source of food – leaves rich in vitamin C, citrus fruit such as Nabuk. Our trained **Midwives, First Aiders** and **Paravets** are saving lives of humans and animals.

There are **11 Kids for Kids' Health Units** saving lives when across Sudan the health service has virtually collapsed. We have built **5 Veterinary Centres** to ensure our Goats, Donkeys and Chickens are healthy. Our **14 Kindergartens** are providing a safe space to learn. More than 9 million children across the country have already missed more than a year's schooling.

So many more children are in desperate need. Please can you help us reach them?

We need to be ready. As soon as it is safe to do so, we will be doing all we can to provide as many of our sustainable projects as possible - large and small. Worryingly we already know that costs will be so much more as inflation continues to soar.

Food



We are delivering Sacks of Seed (£15 each) now for food and planting - but in some areas

it is too late, because flooding has delayed planting. These villages will need sacks of seed to grind into flour to feed their families during the coming months as they will have grown nothing to feed their families.

Kids Kitchen Kits (£25 for one family) will give fresh ingredients and vital nutrients to one family with children aged 5 and under.

As soon as our **Goats (£50 each)** are in markets again, they are top of our list- our Goats are miracle workers, providing protein-rich milk to malnourished children - not just now but for generations to come.

Water



Water is urgently needed—but drilling is not possible whilst there is uncontrollable violence.

Spare parts (£500) are needed now to fix handpumps that have been working day and night.

Jerry cans (£18 for 2) are vital in every village and many people are in need of a strong **Crossbred Donkey (£150)** to carry water. A full jerry weighs 25 kilos.

Once we can start drilling again, **Handpumps (£6,500 each)** are urgently needed in many villages and bear the name of your choice.

Healthcare



Mosquito Nets (£18 for 2) and **Double Blankets (£25 each)** are vital to protect children from malaria and chest infections which can be fatal when they are already weak with malnutrition.

The health of children is linked to the health of our animals and, with very little veterinary care in villages, we need **Vaccinations to treat worms and parasites (£105 for 100)**

We are desperate to train more **Paravets (£370 each)**, **First Aiders (£400 each)** and **Midwives (2,000 each)** to save more lives just as soon as we can.
